Shooting Suspect in Custody

Markus Wall was taken into custody shortly after midnight in the 100 block of East Carolyn Drive. Wall was spotted around 8:40 pm Monday night in the Broadway and 1st Street area. Garland K-9 was called in and tracked Wall for several hours. The K-9 located Wall hiding in a garage on Carolyn. Wall is charged with aggravated assault-deadly weapon. Bond is set at \$50,000.

Update on Shooting Suspect - 10/21/2013

Police have identified the suspect in yesterday's shooting at the Spanish Stone Apartments. He is 23 year old Markus Anthony Wall. A warrant for aggravated assault has been issued for his arrest. Anyone knowing his whereabouts is asked to contact the Garland Police Department. Markus Wall is described as a white male, 5'10" tall, 140 pounds, with brown hair and hazel eyes. Police Search for Shooting Suspect - 10/20/2013

Garland Police responded to the report of a shooting at the Spanish Stone Apartments, 1520 W. Kingsley Road, just before 3:30 pm this afternoon. When they arrived they found a 32 year old male who had been shot multiple times. He was transported to Baylor Hospital of Dallas where he was later listed in stable condition with nonlife threatening injuries.

Police initiated a search for the suspect and believed it was a male in his mid-twenties who may stay in the apartments. Witnesses told police they believed the man had gone inside an apartment in the rear of the complex. Garland SWAT team members later made entry into that apartment and were unable to locate anyone inside.

Police detectives are continuing their investigation into why the shooting occurred along with the exact identity of the shooter and his location.
