



## Family Night Out: Food Fun and Fireworks Fact Sheet

- The following activities are scheduled for the Family Night Out:
  - Food trucks, fun and games start at 6 pm
  - Live entertainment starts at 7 pm
  - Fireworks start at 9:30 pm
  
- Public parking is available at the following locations:
  - West side of the recreation center
  - Central Park ball fields - accessible from W. Ave F and S. Glenbrook
  - East of the Granger Annex on S. 10<sup>th</sup> St.
  - Central Park tennis courts
  - No parking will be permitted on the grass or private property
  
- The entertainment will be on the multiuse field between the tennis courts and ball fields, south of the recreation center. The stage will be set up on the field in front of the bleachers looking west with fireworks to the east.
  
- There are a few things we ask you to leave at home for everyone's safety and enjoyment. Please don't bring any alcohol, glass containers, or other sharp objects to the events, and help keep our parks clean by picking up your trash and placing it in a trash can.
