


The Nerd presented by Garland Civic Theatre

Tickets to see this one-of-a-kind local band are only \$15. For tickets, call 972-205-2790 Monday through Friday, 10 am – 4 pm.




Brain Tumor Society Fundraiser



tional "Mexican Bingo" and its 54 personages will be remembered. Be prepared to be trans-




